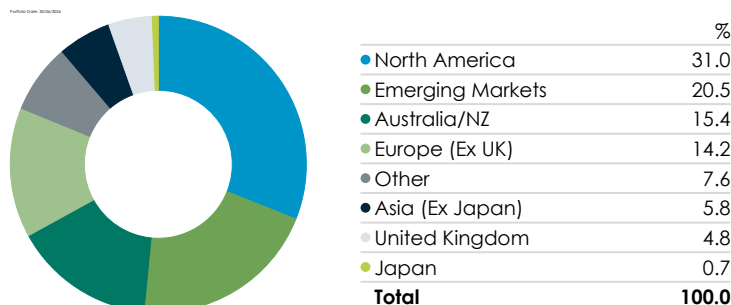

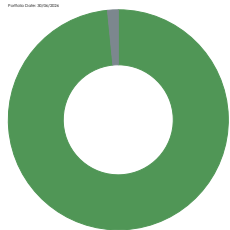

FUND COMMENTARY

Acasta Global Fund was the only positive contributor, driven by event-driven gains in Par Health, cinema holdings, and several restructuring and convertible situations, with only a lagging Constellation Oil equity stake and a tight-spread credit hedge as offsets. Polar Star Fund Ltd was the largest detractor as the Iran ceasefire unwound the geopolitical premium behind its oil, corn and wheat positions, with coffee and cattle exposures adding further losses from unrelated supply shocks. Arnott Opportunities Fund lost money after rotating out of semiconductor exposure just before the market kept bidding those names higher, with gains in mobility shorts and aerospace/industrials longs only partly offsetting the miss. Argonaut Absolute Return Fund saw its value-and-quality process squeezed as low-quality, speculative names rallied on AI enthusiasm, hurling both the short hedge book and the cheap long book, compounded by a wrong-way airline short. Steyn Capital Global EM Hedge Fund posted a small loss concentrated in a gold miner tracking bullion's pullback and a Hong Kong hotel holding, cushioned by a luxury-goods long and a Korean arbitrage trade.

June proved a difficult month across almost the entire roster: seven of the eight underlying managers detracted from performance, and only Acasta Global Fund finished the month in positive territory. The common thread across the detractors was the unwinding of geopolitical and defensive risk premia that had built up earlier in the year. A U.S.-brokered memorandum of understanding between the United States and Iran, signed 17 June, initiated a 60-day ceasefire tied to the reopening of the Strait of Hormuz, sharply reducing the risk premium embedded in energy, gold and other safe-haven positioning. At the same time, the first FOMC meeting under new Fed Chair Kevin Warsh struck a distinctly hawkish tone, repricing front-end U.S. rates higher and reinforcing a "higher-for-longer" narrative. Layered on top of this, equity markets continued to narrowly reward AI-capex and semiconductor-related names, working against several of the fund's value-oriented and quality-biased long/short managers.

The fund's June weakness was concentrated in two distinct pockets: strategies most exposed to the abrupt deescalation of Middle East geopolitical risk and the accompanying reversal in energy, gold and defensive positioning (notably Polar Star, and to a lesser extent the gold and energy exposures within L1 Capital and Steyn Capital), and managers running structurally short books against a narrow, AI-capex-driven equity rally that punished value and quality biases (VT Argonaut and Arnott Opportunities). Acasta Global Fund was the only underlying strategy to benefit meaningfully from idiosyncratic, event-driven credit and convertible catalysts that were largely insulated from this macro reversal.

There has been no material change in the composition of the portfolio.

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GLOSSARY

Annualised Performance: Annualised performance shows longer term performance rescaled to a 1-year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Max Drawdown is the maximum loss from a peak to a trough of a portfolio before a new peak is attained. Max drawdown is an indicator of downside risk over a specified time period.

Sharpe Ratio is a measure for calculating risk adjusted return. It is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of total risk.

Fund of Fund: A portfolio that invests in portfolios of collective investment schemes, which levy their own charges, which could result in a higher fee structure for these portfolios.

Liquidity Risk: Refers to the possibility that an investor may not be able to invest or disinvest when they want to. This may occur during a period of adverse market trading conditions where the Manager may not be able to buy or sell the Fund's investments because opportunities to do so are limited.

Net Asset Value (NAV): The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.
