

INVESTMENT AND RETURN OBJECTIVE

The objective of the fund is to outperform the JSE all-share index by more than 5% p.a. after fees over any 5-10 year rolling period.

INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

We invest in outstanding companies when, *and only when*, we can buy at a discount to a conservatively derived fair value. Our portfolio is concentrated in our 8-15 highest conviction ideas.

INVESTMENT PROCESS

The fund manager follows a fundamental and fact-based process that systematically sieves out companies that do not meet our strict quality and valuation criteria. The end result is that we invest in outstanding companies, run by competent managers, trading at attractive valuations.

WHO SHOULD INVEST

Investors who: (i) understand and share our investment philosophy, (ii) have a long-term investment horizon, (iii) enjoys owning part interests in outstanding businesses (not trading in and out of stocks).

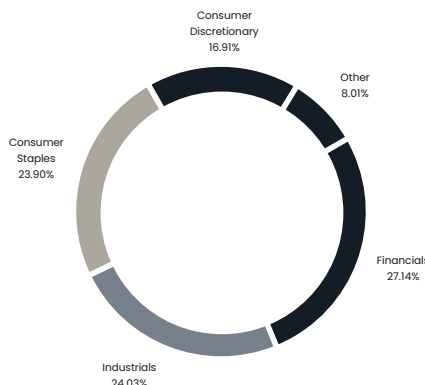

FUND COMMENTARY

The JSE All-Share index (our benchmark) returned -5.50% over the eight-month period since 1 August 2023, when the Steen Partners Fund (class A) was launched, and 31 March 2024. You would have seen from your quarterly account statements that our fund outperformed its benchmark by a sizeable margin over this period*. As always, I remind that:

1. Performance, absolute or relative, is meaningless over such a short period of time.
2. Our portfolio is very different from that of the JSE, and our method of operation very different from that of most other fund managers. You should thus expect material variances in our returns, positive or negative, relative to our benchmark over such short periods.
3. There will be periods of negative returns and underperformance.
4. Success is measured relative to the performance of the JSE, not in absolute terms. I will be more satisfied with our performance in a year when we are down -10% and the JSE -20%, compared to a year when we are up 20% and the JSE 25%.

The objective of our fund is long-term capital appreciation above market averages. We should deem ourselves successful if we outperform the JSE by a sizeable margin (>5% p.a.) after fees over any five year period.

GLOSSARY

Annualised Performance: Annualised performance shows longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Highest & Lowest Performance: The highest and lowest performance for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.

NAV: The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.

Alpha: Denotes the outperformance of the fund over the benchmark.

Sharpe Ratio: The Sharpe ratio is used to indicate the excess return the portfolio delivers over the risk free rate per unit of risk adopted by the fund.

Standard Deviation: The deviation of the return stream relative to its own average.

Max Drawdown: The maximum peak to trough loss suffered by the Fund since inception.

Max Gain: Largest increase in any single month.

Qualified Hedge Funds only allow Qualified Investors to invest. A Qualified Investor, is a person who invests an initial minimum amount of R1 million and who has demonstrated knowledge and experience in financial and business matters which would enable the investor to assess the merits and risks of a hedge fund or has appointed a Financial Services Provider (FSP) who has demonstrable knowledge and experience to advise the investor regarding the merits and risks of a hedge fund investment.

FUND SPECIFIC RISK

During the phase in period TER's do not include information gathered over a full year. Transaction Costs (TC) is the percentage of the value of the Fund incurred as costs relating to the buying and selling of the Fund's underlying assets. Transaction costs are a necessary cost in administering the Fund and impacts Fund returns. It should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of Fund, investment decisions of the investment manager and the TER.

Prices are published monthly and are available on the Prescient website.

Performance has been calculated using net NAV to NAV numbers with income reinvested.

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*Performance Fee: The Fund charges a base and performance fee. Performance fees are payable on outperformance of the benchmark using a participation rate of 10%. A permanent high water mark is applied, which ensures that performance fees will only be charged on new performance. There is no cap on the performance fee.
